The Wyre Forest & Hagley Project is a service for all local parents who have a child at Primary School and who live in Kidderminster, Bewdley, Stourport or Hagley.

If your child has recently started having a difficult time at school, or things are difficult for you at home, then Anna will be available for you to have a chat with, in confidence.

Anna will be in school from 2:45pm until 3:20pm on Monday 5th June for a 'drop in' session - no appointment necessary.

In our PSHE lessons this term, we will be discussing the NSPCC's PANTS rules. These are designed to teach pupils how to stay safe, without giving explicit information or telling scary stories.

In the lesson, children will learn about the 'PANTS' acrostic, which stands for:

- Privates are private.
- Always remember your body belongs to you.
- No means no
- Talk about secrets that upset you
- Speak up, someone can help.

The lesson will be fully age-appropriate.
