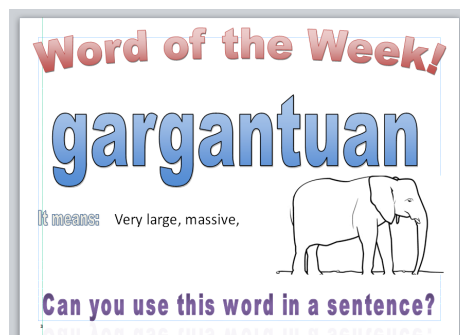
Youth Makes Music - Colours 2017 (Years 3 & 4)
