

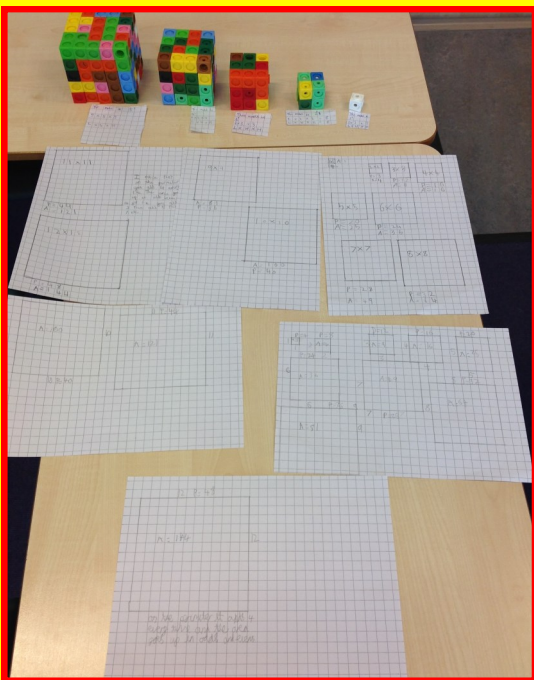
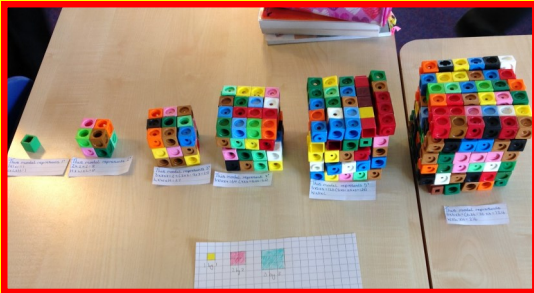


SPS Today for 20th May 2016 Aspiring to Excellence

Whole school attendance based on pupils attending last week was up at 96.50%. We had two classes who tied for the magical top spot, both having 100% attendance, and those were our Year 6 pupils in Cedar and Rowan. Very well done to them in SATs week.

Not far behind in third place came Oak with 99.23% and in fourth a creditable performance from Elm on 98.82%.
