Again the dangers of the game Roblox have been highlighted this week.

Attached with this newsletter is an information sheet aimed at parents and informing them of how Roblox works and how to keep your child safe while using the game. For children under 13 years old it is very important that certain settings have been turned off.

Make sure that In-Game Chat has been disabled, restrict the payment options within the game, talk to your child about 'Griefing' and check the shared information section to make sure that your child is not giving away 'Personal Information'. Make sure your child follows the rules of S.M.A.R.T.
