## Culture of Safeguarding

### Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare review

Thank you for your responses to our questionnaires we have had over 60 replies.

Last year's questionnaires we were asked to:

- Make playtimes more fun.
  - We have more than doubled activities available at lunch time including: IT club; library Club, Activity Corner, Designers Club; Carrot Shop; Crafty Chippies; Kits Academy - twice a week, Harriers twice a week. This Summer term we have ensured the games field is available for everyone at lunch time.
- Deliver extra Online Safety lessons
  - This year we have included online safety lessons in our weekly enrichment lessons.
  - We have invited parents to meetings led by Mr Owen the Online Safety Lead and invited parents to open online safety lessons.

This year's results and comments will be displayed on our safeguarding board at the front of the school, including:

**Parents/Carers Agree or Strongly Agree:**

- My child is well looked after at this school 98%
- Stourport Primary Staff respond effectively to my or my child's concerns or worries 97%
- Stourport Primary is well led and managed 98%
- Stourport Primary staff take my child's safety and well-being seriously. 98%

**Children** were also asked what they thought about their well-being in school.

- **95% - 100% of children agree:**
- There is an adult at school I can talk to if something is worrying me.
- I feel safe when I am at school.
- My school encourages me to respect people from other backgrounds and to treat everyone equally.

**100% of Elderberry Nursery children agree:**

- I enjoy nursery
- Children are kind in nursery
- Nursery help me when I'm sad.
- I'm kind to everyone even if they don't look the same as me.

The staff are all enthusiastic and hardworking and appreciate your compliments and we value your feedback to improve.

We welcome parents to talk to us who have suggestions for improvements particularly with communication so we can try and improve our practice.

Next school year we will run an Enrichment group on Safety and Well-being which will include work on concerns which some children have voiced, such as, friendships.

This information will be put towards our School Development Plan next year.
