A Culture of Safeguarding

As a follow up to last weeks Anti Bullying Day, this week we're going to look at Online Bullying with the help of our friends at National Online Safety.

Online Bullying or as it is sometimes called Cyber Bullying is bullying that takes place on the Internet or via electronic devices such as iPads, phones etc.

Should anyone be on the receiving end of Online Bullying, they don't need to suffer. Evidence can be gathered and then passed onto the relevant parties to get the problem resolved. It is very hard to argue against electronic evidence.

Attached to this newsletter is an information leaflet about Online Bullying for you to have a look over. It gives advice on what is Online Bullying and why it happens to who to tell to get the problems resolved.
